
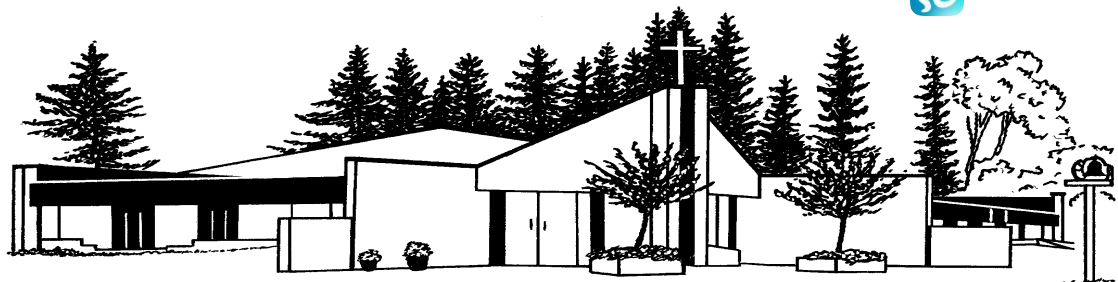

### **SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER**

Acts 8:5-8, 14-17      The Holy Spirit came down upon the new believers.  
1Peter 3:15-18        It is better to suffer for good deeds than for evil ones.  
John 14:14-21         Jesus speaks about the coming of the Spirit.

*These are the "Sundays of the promise." In his discourse in John's gospel, Jesus prepares the uncomprehending disciples for a time when he would no longer be physically present. In return he offers eternal life wrapped in the Father's love for those who do his will.*

# SACRAMENTS

## **Infant Baptism:**

The parents must be registered members of the parish. Contact the parish office, 752-4219, Someone will contact you to begin the process of baptismal preparation.

## **First Reconciliation and First Eucharist:**

Preparation for these Sacraments is ordinarily in the second grade in our Religious Formation program. Preparation also includes conferences with parents. Contact Heidi Durbin, 253-4886.

## **Confirmation**

Risen Christ children prepare for the sacrament of Confirmation as late high school students, with the rite being celebrated as needed. Candidates are enrolled in the Religious Formation program. Contact Fr. Stan Rog, 752-4219.

## **Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA):**

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process of inquiring, faith-sharing, instruction, and liturgy for those who seek to become Catholics. All who are interested in inquiring about the Catholic faith are welcome. Contact Fr. Stan Rog, 752-4219.

## **Rite of Christian Initiation of Children (RCIC):**

The process of initiation is adapted to meet the needs of unbaptized children or children who have been baptized but have had no formation in the faith. These are children of catechetical age, who have attained the age of reason and are capable of receiving and nurturing a personal faith. Contact Heidi Durbin, 253-4886.
