
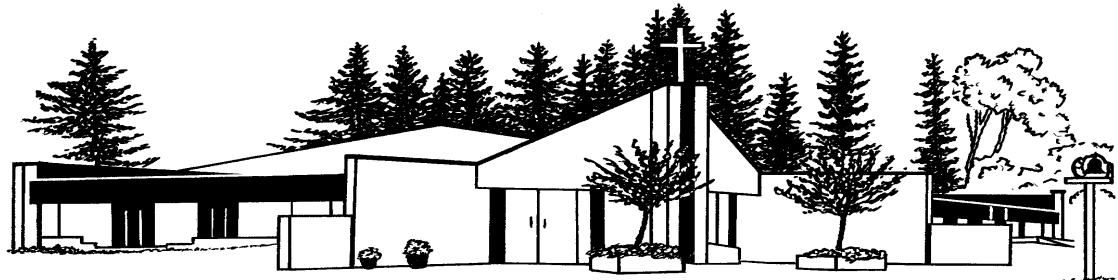

**COMMUNITY GARDEN**

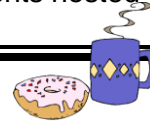

**PROGRAM FOR LAY MINISTRY (PFLM)**

**Theological Foundations**

Gather with Carroll College Theology Faculty for this enriching faith formation series experience as we endeavor to *"Think with the Church"*. Engage in fellowship, excellent instruction and gain a theological foundation through this unique offering.

This course is primarily offered for personal enrichment. Always discuss ahead of time with your pastor if you feel called to volunteer or engage in parish ministry in the future.

Cycle one and two will be held in the Kalispell Deanery with Cycle One at St. John Paul II Parish in Bigfork. Cycle one will begin October 21-22, 2017 with monthly meetings, completing on May 26-27, 2018.

Fees are \$600 for Cycles One and Two (full payment for course)

\$300 at the start of each Cycle. Payment must be submitted before the start of the Cycle. Commitment to attend both Cycles is expected.

\$150 at the start and mid-way through each Cycle. Payment must be submitted before the start of the Cycle. Payment for 2<sup>nd</sup> half of a Cycle must be made before January of the Cycle year. Commitment to attend both Cycles is expected.

Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9.      The Lord is slow to anger and rich in kindness and fidelity.  
2 Corinthians 13:11-13      The God of love and peace will be with you.  
John 3:16-18      God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.

*The evil that sin brings to the world – our separation from one another by hatred, bigotry, violence, oppression, injustice – remains when human beings are unable to accept salvation through Jesus Christ. We thus condemn ourselves to live with these separations.*

Yes this reign of sin is not the final word. The primeval history is followed by the call of Abraham, a man of faith, who was to be the bearer of the promise to many nations (Genesis 12:1-4). Throughout the Bible we find this struggle between sin and repentance. God's judgment on evil is followed by God's seeking out a sinful people.
