
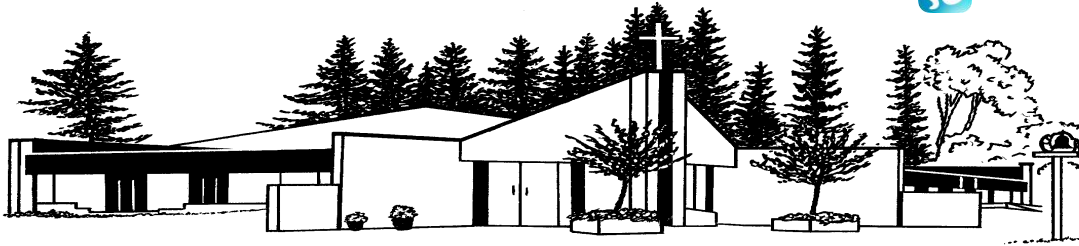

THE PASTORALS ON SUNDAY

SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Isaiah 62:1-5,

The Lord rejoices in you and makes your land a spouse.

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

There are different gifts but the same Spirit.

John 2:1-12

Jesus performed the first of his signs at Cana. Thus he did reveal his glory.

At Cana Jesus was faced with a request he did not seem ready to grant. He chose to be obedient, however, and so he "revealed his glory." We are also faced with choices for which we may not feel ready. Moral choices for peace and social justice are difficult, and often controversial. It is tempting to turn our backs on the issues, but our decisions can reveal the Lord's glory to us.

In focusing on some of the central economic issues and choices in American life in the light of moral principles, we are aware that the movement from principle to policy is complex and difficult and that although moral values are essential in determining public policies, they do not dictate specific solutions. They must interact with empirical data, with historical, social, and political realities, and with competing demands on limited resources. The soundness of our prudential judgments depends not only on the moral force of our principles, but also on the accuracy of our information and the validity of our assumptions. ◆Economic Justice, 134

A STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

In today's reading from the Gospel of Luke we hear the proclamation of the baptism of Jesus with "all the people." Indeed, "heaven was opened," and the Father announced his special favor. Whenever we partake of the body and blood of Christ, heed his call in our daily lives, share his Good News, become instruments of his transforming justice and peace, heaven is opened to us, and through the Holy Spirit, the Lord announces his special favor on us as well. A good stewardship reflection this week might be this: How, or in what ways, have we personally experienced God's special favor in our lives?

MARRIAGE MATTERS

We often confuse humility with humiliation. To humiliate someone means to injure their self-respect or to make them feel ashamed. Humility, on the other hand, is simply regarding ourselves honestly, and it is necessary for a happy marriage! When we lack humility, we tend to cut ourselves down or puff ourselves up, or both. We become defensive, argumentative and unforgiving. In this weekend's readings, both John and Jesus show great humility. They know exactly who they are, and therefore they can accomplish their missions. Put humility to work in your mission, too!

- * Ask forgiveness
 - * Recognize that you and your spouse both have valuable opinions
 - * Ask God for an honest view of your own strengths and weaknesses
 - * Focus on your spouse's strengths, entrusting his/her weaknesses to the Holy Spirit
- To grow together in this virtue, attend the Valentine's Date Night on February 9th!

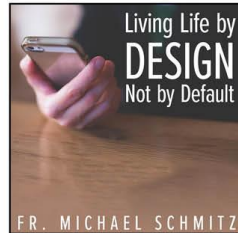
