A STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

In today's second reading, Saint Paul makes a list of gifts dispensed to members of the Christian community by the Holy Spirit. Each gift bestowed has a specific purpose for the person for whom it is intended: wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, mighty deeds, prophecy, discernment, tongues, and interpretation. Good stewards know these gifts are not meant to be kept hidden by the recipient but to be shared with the community and beyond. As we begin a new year, let us reflect on the gift the Holy Spirit has given to each of us. Do we recognize this gift? How was it intended that we use this gift? Are we being good stewards of this gift?

Extraordinary Time

As we begin the second week of Ordinary Time, it's a good time to think about our "ordinary lives", which can often be considered boring. This weekend's Gospel teaches us that God thinks our "ordinary lives" are meant for more than a dull drudgery. At a wedding feast, Jesus makes water into the choicest wine. That same Jesus is present in the sacrament of your marriage, ready to elevate the ordinary into the extraordinary! To get there, "Do whatever He tells you", perhaps by:

* Finding out why the Church teaches difficult things, such as

using natural family planning instead of contraception

* Having your marriage serve the Church by mentoring the engaged

* Clearing a weekend to attend Worldwide Marriage Encounter or Living in Love



Council #8329 Evergreen, has joined Knights of Columbus Councils in the vicinity of the Highway 93 corridor to partner with Hope Pregnancy of Kalispell & Care Net of Missoula to purchase a mobile medical unit to provide outreach to areas along that corridor in Western Montana.

Western Montana Knights Councils have agreed to raise money towards that goal by selling raffle tickets. The goal is to raise \$50,000 by May 1, 2019. \$7,000 will go towards prizes; \$43,000 towards the purchase of the mobile medical unit.

Prizes: 1st-\$5,000; 2nd \$2,000; 3rd-6th One week stay at Lake Pend Oreille Resort. Tickets are \$50 each and will be on sale in the social area after Mass until May. Your KC Council will have a drawing for a raffle ticket at the January 27th breakfast!


