
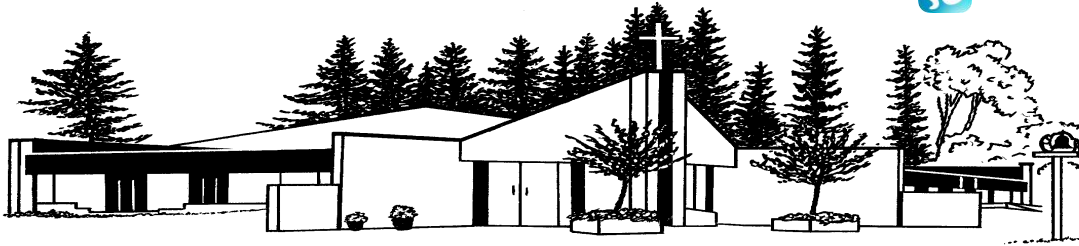

THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Jeremiah 1:4-5, 17-19 Before you were born I dedicated you.

1 Corinthians 12:31-13:13 The greatest of these is love.

Luke 4:21-30 No prophet gains acceptance in the prophet's native place.

The church is calling us to be Jeremiah. As Christians we were dedicated by God in our baptismal call to ministry. This is especially difficult in our own community. But the Lord made Jeremiah a "fortified city," Jesus walked through the crowd unharmed, and we will receive the strength and protection to do what needs to be done.

Solidarity with others and faithfulness to the gospel demand that we respond to people's genuine needs and hungers, even those of which they may be unaware....Some social hungers may indicate the presence of oppression, preventing people from developing in an atmosphere of peace and justice.

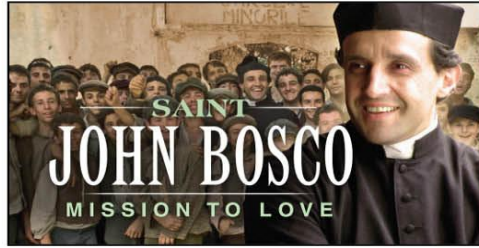
