
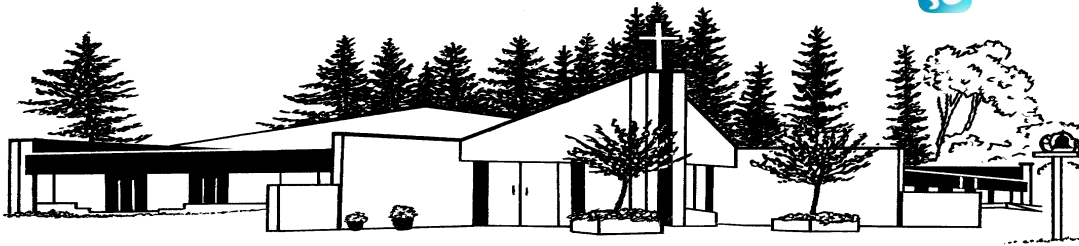

Isaiah 6:1-2, 3-8 Here I am, send me!
1 Corinthians 15:1-11 This is what we preach and this is what you believed.

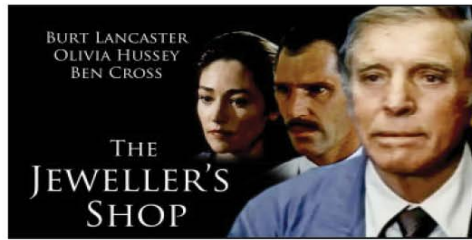
