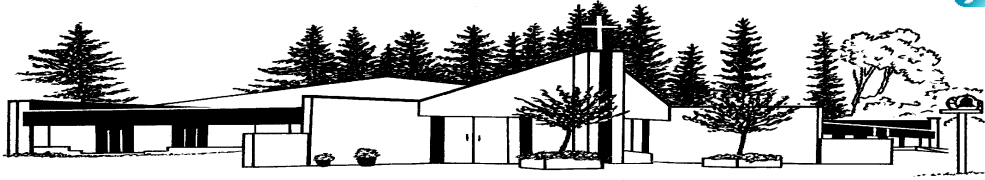

PRACTICE OF CHARITY

But where do we see the resurrection we proclaim? On the road to Emmaus, the disciples gradually come to recognize Jesus’ presence among them.

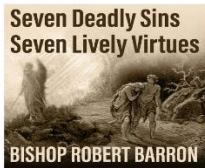
God's School of Trust | Divine Mercy | Episode 1
