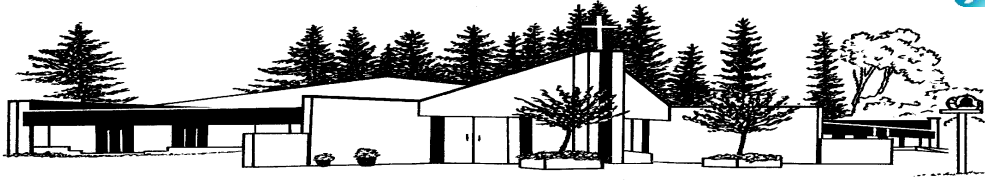

HOW TO LIGHT A VOTIVE PRAYER CANDLE

Find the location of the small votive candles. Identify a candle that has not been lit. Light the unlit candle you have chosen using the candle lighter. Make a donation for the candle. There is a small box on the metal stand in which you can put the money. **The donation is completely voluntary and helps defray the cost of the candles.**

With the light of faith, we petition our Lord in prayer, or petition the saint to pray with us and for us to the Lord. The light also shows a special reverence and our desire to remain present to the Lord in prayer even though we may depart and go about our daily business.
